

**Opening the Net:** (enter proper DTMF code to put the repeater in "Net Mode")

"Good evening and welcome to the weekly Astronomy Net, this is (name & callsign) and I will be your Net Control Operator for tonight's Net. We meet here on the Dupage Amateur Radio Club repeater every Thursday evening at 8:30 P.M. This Net is using both the 2-meter and 220 repeaters. The 220 frequency is 224.68 MHz. with a 110.9 Hz PL."

"Before we begin the net, is there anyone with emergency or priority traffic?" (pause...)

"Our name is the **South West Astronomy Observers Group, or SWAOG**. We are not an astronomy club, we are a group of ham radio operators and amateur astronomers who like to go observing and share our hobby via ham radio. We like to meet here to discuss the hobby of astronomy and plan observing sessions. This net is open to ALL amateur radio operators and 3<sup>rd</sup> party traffic IS permitted, providing it is done as per the F.C.C. rules. Everyone is encouraged to check-in and participate!"

"Here is how the net will be structured this evening, we will have (  # of  ) segments in our net.

- 1 - the **check in round** (short time & regular check-ins)
- 2 - the **Astronomy Report** (from Net Control, OR from one of the check-ins, if available)
- 3 - the **traffic round** (including any observing reports)
- 4 - The **Space/Sci-Fi Trivia** round (or Featured Segment - if one is available)
- 5 - **Dark Site Planning Segment** (the week of the SWAOG Observing Sessions only)"

**Check-in Procedure:**

"When checking in please give your **CALL SIGN, FIRST NAME, and LOCATION**, and state if **you have any traffic** or anything to share with the Net during our Traffic Round, or let me know if you are 'just listening'. Net Control will take 3 check-ins at a time and then read back and verify the call signs. Net Control only will call on stations that have traffic for the net. If you checked in as 'just listening' and you later decide that you have something you would like to share with the group, just let the Net Control Operator know, and your traffic will be acknowledged. People listening to the net on scanners can check in by sending an email to "**net-control@swaog.com**".

➤ **(Take check-ins)**
